Stage 1 Learn

- Carry out a gap analysis to identify the parts of the Standard which are not adequately covered
- Obtain consultancy if needed

Stage 2 Plan

- Select a suitable Certification Body for you
- Arrange a pre-assessment visit (*optional but recommended) and implement any corrective actions identified


